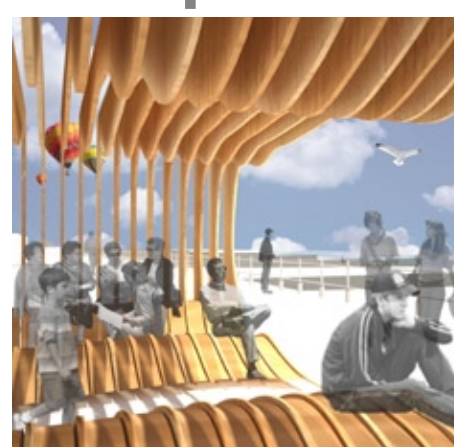


Grand Designs Live 2009
